<p><b>Parents:</b> <i>Skin cancer is preventable. Over 1.3 million new cases will be diagnosed this year, an average of more than 2 cases every minute! One person dies from skin cancer every hour. It's important to protect kids from the sun's UV rays - use sunscreen of SPF 15 or higher, wear sunglasses and hats and seek shade, whether at the pool or beach, or in any outdoor activities year-round.</i></p>
